The *Hazardous Materials* assignments (Modules 29 & 31) must be completed by the end of **February**. This is your annual Haz-mat Refresher.

All members are encouraged to participate in the online training, regardless of whether or not it is required for your certification level. Participation will not only increase or refresh your knowledge, but will also increase our department's average for Company Training for ISO.

If you do not have a computer or internet available for you to use at your home or work, you may come by Stations 1, 2, 3, or 4 at anytime that is convenient for you (24 hrs. a day, 7 days a week) and use the computers at those locations.
